Deadlines to schedule senior meeting:

If your <u>FIRST</u> Application Deadline is:	**Contact your counselor and schedule your meeting no later than:
October 15	September 16
November 1	September 23
November 15	October 7
December 1	November 4
All others	November 15

Seniors must complete the following tasks prior to scheduling a senior meeting:

1. Complete the **Senior Data Sheet** - the more detailed the better as this is your counselor's most valuable resource when writing the counselor statement! You can find the Senior Data Sheet in SCOIR under *Surveys*.

2. Upload your **Resume** to SCOIR OR fill out the Activities & Achievements Section in SCOIR.

3. Move colleges from **"Following"** to **"Applying"** in SCOIR (please indicate which application you will use (i.e., Common App) and whether you are applying early action, early decision, regular, etc.

The college must be in the "Applying" column for your counselor to send your school records.

4. Set up a **CommonApp account at <u>www.commonapp.org</u>** and have your username and password available for your senior meeting.

5. Add colleges to **"My Colleges"** in the Common App and complete the **Education Section** in the Common App. Here is the information that you'll need:

6. Touch base with the **teacher** who agreed to write a **letter of recommendation** for you and **notify the teacher of your first college application deadline**.

A few other reminders:

- Please don't put your counselor email or your teacher email addresses into the Common App because your school counselor will send your letters of recommendation through SCOIR instead.
- The parent/caregiver questionnaire in SCOIR will close on September 9th.
- Save the date! The WA Counseling Department will be offering a MEFA financial aid presentation on October 11th at 6:30pm in the PAC. More information to follow.
